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A peek at our week:

ELA	In ELA, we are learning letter sounds, how to correctly write the letter sounds and we are beginning to read and write words with the sounds we have learned. In comprehension, we are listening to Stories. This will help students develop an awareness of language to help them become both better writers and readers.
