Background:

Due to the scope of bond construction work at Schwegler Elementary School, playground equipment will be purchased and installed. District staff and Schwegler administration have given input to the placement and design. The purchase and installation of new playground equipment is needed to provide a safe, sufficient, and enjoyable experience for all students and community members.

Bids and Specifications:

The scope of work includes the installation of playground equipment for ages 5-12. All playground pieces meet and/or exceed the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) standards, which is the Standard Consumer Safety Performance Specification for Playground Equipment for public use. The total cost for the playground equipment is \$49,991.34. The equipment and accessories have been priced through a cooperative purchasing contract with National Joint Powers Alliance.

Recommendation:

The Facility Planning Committee recommends board approval of a contract with PlayPower LT Farmington, Inc. for the purchase and installation of playground equipment at Schwegler Elementary School.
