Background:

Following voter approval in April 2013 of a \$92.5 million school bond issue to improve facilities, enhance technology and expand career and technical educational opportunities, administration transitioned from bond planning to implementation.

A critical piece of the bond construction packages for every school project includes providing safe and secure entries into the buildings. When life safety systems were replaced or upgraded, some card readers became obsolete or no longer compatible with the new systems, requiring the purchase of replacement units. The costs and locations are identified below and are coming to the board for approval.
