## Background:

The Diploma Completion Program, Adult Basic Education/GED/ESL programs and the Juvenile Detention and Day School Education programs use technology as an integral part of instruction.

Computers in these programs are among the oldest in the district and have grown unreliable and in need of frequent service. Administration is proposing that new computers be purchased for these programs so that reliable devices will be in the hands of students.
