Background:

Construction to buildings within Lawrence Public Schools has created a need for additional security cameras. The district has established the Axis P3224-LV & P3224 LVE security cameras as the districtwide solution.

Rationale:

As the bond construction phase continues, additional security cameras are necessary to provide adequate protection for the district, staff, and students. To ensure continuity and reduce possible disruptions, it is important to purchase new, update existing, and maintain the same model of security cameras throughout the district.
