Re: Transfer of Summer School Funds to General Fund

## Background:

Under 2015 House Substitute for Senate Bill 7, the Board of Education can elect to transfer back to General Fund, unencumbered fund balances from certain special revenue funds. The Summer School Fund is one of these funds. The Board of Education for the 2015-16 budget year did not initially make an election to do this. Instead, the budget was built with smaller transfers to the special revenue funds that receive transfers and in turn using unencumbered cash balances in lieu of the transfer.

The Summer School Fund does not receive a transfer from the General or LOB Funds, so there is no transfer to reduce. After careful review of the summer school fund's unencumbered cash balances, plus revenues and expenditures over time, there is a portion of funds that could be transferred out of the Summer School Fund and not have a negative impact on current summer school programming.

## Rationale:

Current summer school programing is the Novice Music program and the high school Summer Weights and Conditioning program. Both are fee-based programs. The fee charged is to offset expenditures incurred as closely as possible.

The unencumbered cash balance has been stable and, in fact, increased some over the past four years.
