Background

At its October 8, 2017 the board of education approved an agreement with Gould Evans for furniture design and procurement for Free State High and Lawrence High Schools for the 2017 Bond Project.

As part of the design process, the Gould Evans interior design team has worked with administrative staff to establish Phase I classroom furniture options. Gould Evans received, tabulated and reviewed the bids with administration and recommends the contracts be awarded to the following furniture vendors for 9 new classrooms in the new addition, 4 typical classrooms and one science classroom at Free State High School.
