## Background

On July 24, 2017, the board of education approved the renewal of Cisco SmartNet Maintenance contract through Alexander Open Systems (AOS) in the amount of \$84,140.83. In order to get all renewals to align, there is an adjustment to the contract as previously approved. There is an increase of \$2,573.23, making the total cost \$86,714.06.

## Rationale:

Warranty maintenance and support is critical to ensure network viability, security, and operations. It allows the Information Technology Services team support tools to most efficiently avoid, pre-empt and minimize downtime, undetected bugs, configuration conflicts, and equipment outages. The updated renewal amount allows for additional contract extensions to align renewal dates.

## Recommendation:

Administration recommends the board of education approve the renewal adjustment of additional funds on the Cisco SmartNet Maintenance Contract to align contract renewal dates through AOS at a total cost of \$86,714.06 to be paid from the Technology General Fund for the 2017-18 school year.
