

Calendar Parameters:

Kansas State Statute #72-1106:

K.S.A. 72-1106. "The school term shall consist of not less than 186 school days for pupils attending kindergarten or any of the grades one through 11 and not less than 181 school days for pupils attending grade 12.	All
"(b) Subject to a policy developed and adopted by it, the board of any school district may provide for a school term consisting of school hours." "For pupils attending kindergarten, not less than 465 school hours in each school year; and (2) for pupils attending any of the grades one through 11, not less than 1,116 school hours in each school year; and (3) for pupils attending grade 12, not less than 1,086 school hours in each school year. "	

Board Policy AE- School Year:

Same as state statute, with addition of specification that days not be less than 2.5 hours of kindergarten and 6 hours grades 1-12	All

Board Policy AEA- School Year:

Board will establish a school calendar for each school year. Superintendent will bring a recommended calendar for the next school year presented on or before March 1.

Master Agreement, Article 15- Work Year:

(This article shall serve as a guideline for the development of the school calendar no later than February 1 for the subsequent school year.)

Work year: 186 contract days (new staff- 190 contract days)	
175 student instructional days and 11 non-instructional days for HS, 173 student instructional days and 13 non-instructional days for MS, 170 instructional days and 15 non-instructional days for the elem. (non-instructional to consist of parent/teacher conference days, recording/reporting days and professional development days) Examples are listed in Article.	HS MS EL
Parent/Teacher conference days: Minimum of four for elementary schools Minimum of two for middle schools Minimum of two for high schools	HS MS EL
Recording and reporting days: Minimum of 2.5 for elementary, middle school and high school	
Professional Development days: Minimum of 4.5 for elementary, middle school, and high school	
Planning days: Three for elementary	
Holidays: Labor Day, New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Martin Luther King Day, Christmas Day, Memorial Day	
Vacations: Thanksgiving shall consist of at least 2 school days of vacation Winter vacation shall consist of at least 8 school days of vacation. Two of those days shall be Christmas and New Year's Day Spring vacation at least 5 school days	

Traditional parameters, not required:

First semester completed before winter break	
Graduation not in conflict with KU graduation (KU Grad. May 17)	
Graduation practice the Monday before graduation	
Spring break coincides with KU's spring break (Mar. 9-13)	
At least one inclement weather day built in
