50 minutes ea.

'Traditional' interactive session designed to give the participants a solid understanding of a broader topic.

PERSONALIZED LEARNING Café

50 minutes

An individual working on specific learning goal(s) in a quiet setting.



IGNITE Series

5 minutes ea./20-30 min. per series

An Ignite session is a series of 'talks' where speakers have five minutes to expound on a subject accompanied by 10-20 slides, for 15-30 seconds each, automatically advanced.

I loved having the freedom to find my own sessions, change my mind about a session and switch, collaborating with other teachers from across the district, and being able to meet with district people.

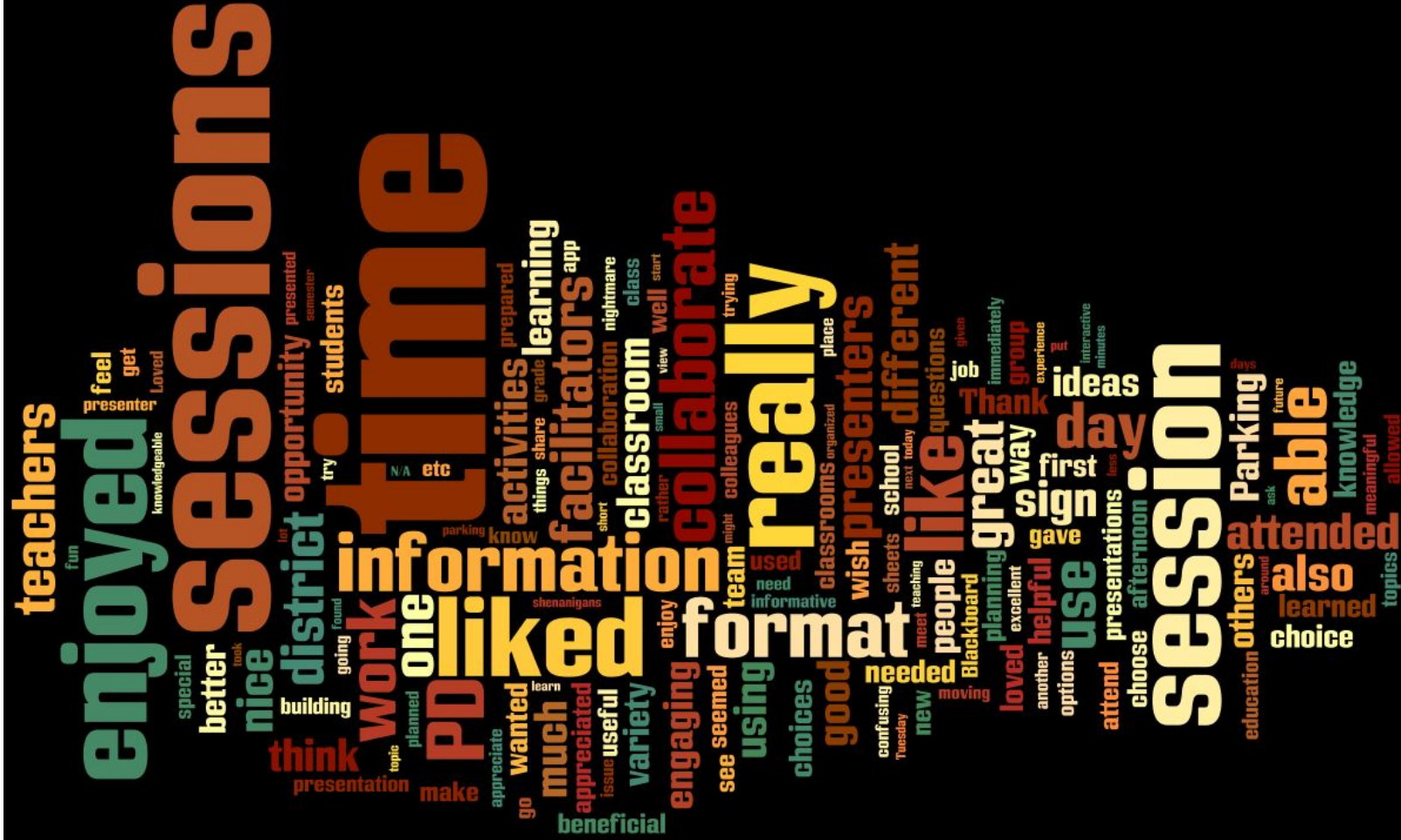
I think the choice of being able to collaborate or go to PD of our choice is better than being forced to sit and get all day.

I liked the variety of formats that were offered and felt that they helped keep me engaged in the sessions while introducing a lot of information in a short amount of time.

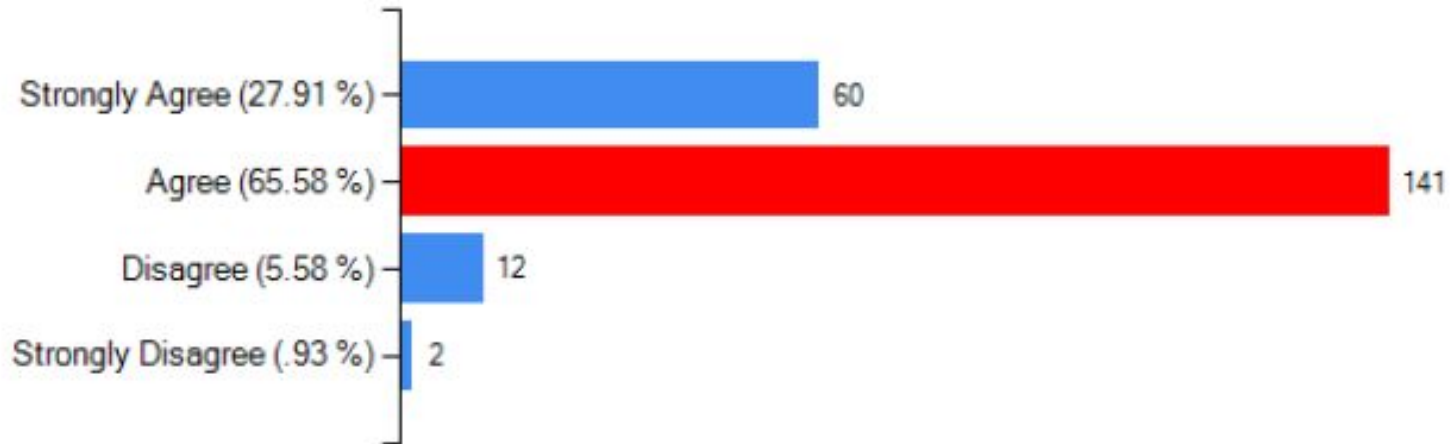

I would personally much rather be told where to go and what the topic will be for an inservice. It is too unstructured and too loosey goosey for me to have no schedule. What I have seen work best is to have all of the teachers in the same grade level work together and have a speaker/topic that applies to that grade level. For example, all of the kindergarten teachers would meet at the same school every time there is a district inservice day. All of the first grade teachers would meet at a different school, etc.
