November 27, 2017

CALL TO ORDER

At 6:01 p.m., Board President Shannon Kimball called to order the regular meeting of the Board of Education.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Upon a motion by Jessica Beeson, seconded by Jill Fincher, the board voted, in a unanimous voice vote, to approve the agenda as published.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:02 pm, upon a motion by Shannon Kimball, seconded by Vanessa Sanburn, the board voted, in a unanimous voice vote, to recess to executive session to discuss personnel matters of non-elected personnel in order to protect the privacy interests of the individuals to be discussed; and with the board to return to open session in this room at 6:30 p.m.

At 6:04 pm, the board returned and indicated that they needed to re-do the motion to recess to executive session in order to include Anna Stubblefield, whom they left out of the initial motion. Upon a motion by Shannon Kimball, seconded by Melissa Johnson, the board voted, in a unanimous voice vote, to recess to executive session to discuss personnel matters of non-elected personnel in order to protect the privacy interests of the individuals to be discussed; with Anna Stubblefield, invited to be present; and with the board to return to open session in this room at 6:45 p.m.

At 6:45 p.m., the board returned and indicated they would break until 7:00 pm.

REPORT OF PRESIDENT OF BOARD OF EDUCATION

President Kimball discussed the board lunch on Nov. 14th at Free State High School in conjunction with Lawrence High. She shared that there was a good discussion regarding our approach to career and technical education and career pathways at both high schools and the college and career center.

President Kimball attended the West Middle School site council on November 14 to update on the status of the superintendent search.

President Kimball attended the Friends of Education Recognition ceremony on November 15. She shared how grateful she was for all the wonderful volunteers who assist in our school district.

President Kimball attended the LEA Fall Mixer on November 16 to thank our educators. She shared that she had fun helping with the drawings for gift baskets and business donations. She extended her thanks to LEA, Lawrence Schools Foundation, Truity Credit Union and sponsors of USD47 for making this event possible.

REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT STUBBLEFIELD

Superintendent Stubblefield reported that we are seeing a good response rate for our staff, parent and community online surveys. She reminded anyone who had not yet participated that we would like to hear their opinions about several district performance measures, the school calendar, high school start times and other topics. The surveys are located on our website. They close at midnight on December 8.

Superintendent Stubblefield recognized and congratulated Lawrence High's student newspaper, The Budget, for earning the National Scholastic Press Association's Pacemaker Award. She shared that we have extended an invitation to adviser Barb Tholen to recognize her students for this award at an upcoming board meeting.

Superintendent Stubblefield also shared congratulations to Free State High School students Li Gordon-Washington and Max Lillich. They are currently the top-ranked debate team in the state of Kansas.

Superintendent Stubblefield shared that she had the pleasure before the fall break to present the Lawrence Master Teacher Award to Julie Battaglia. Ms. Battaglia does an excellent job of teaching sixth-grade science and supporting Liberty Memorial Central Middle School.

REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT STUBBLEFIELD (CONTINUED)

School as a member of its Building Leadership Team and working with us at the district level to assist with the implementation of the Next Generation Science Standards. Superintendent Stubblefield acknowledged that we would nominate Julie to Emporia State University's Kansas Master Teacher program.

Superintendent Stubblefield sent her thanks to the RunLawrence organization and the Woodlawn school community. They host an annual Thanksgiving Day run and donate the majority of event proceeds to our elementary school Marathon Clubs. A record 2,226 runners participated in the 5k and One-Mile Kid Fun Run this year.

Superintendent Stubblefield shared that she will be attending KASB's annual conference this weekend in Wichita.

Superintendent Stubblefield invited parents of students in grades 4-12 and their children to attend an Informational Night to learn about participating in local, regional and state-level Science and Engineering Fairs. This event will be held here at the school district office on December 12 at 6 p.m.

Lastly, Superintendent Stubblefield invited the public to join the board for its upcoming Community Conversation about board goals and student achievement and success on December 14 at 6:30 p.m. in the Lawrence Public Library auditorium. This year's board goals include hosting at least one community conversation per semester to continue to engage the community in our school improvement efforts.

Discussion

South Middle School Name Change

The Lawrence Board of Education provided guidelines and outlined the next steps of the process for re-naming South Middle School to honor Native American culture and to recognize Haskell's part in the original donation of the land used for the school campus.

- There will be an open committee facilitated by Jennifer Attocknie, Coordinator of Native American Services. Carole Cadue-Blackwood, committee member who requested the initial name change; Keith Jones, South Middle School Principal; and a representative from Haskell (TBD) will also be on this committee. Anyone from the community who wishes to participate may do so.
- This meeting will take place on December 7 at 4pm at the Native American Student Services Office at Centennial, 2145 Louisiana Street.
- The sole purpose of this committee will be to **MAKE A RECOMMENDATION** for the name change. (Four different names were proposed at the previous board meeting.)
- This committee will determine if "South" will remain in the new name recommended to the board.
- The committee **WILL** provide two (2) options for the name change with only one having a person's name included.
- The committee will bring their recommendation to the board at the December 11 or January 22 meeting, depending on when a consensus is reached.

Board President Shannon Kimball requested that any individuals who wished to share concerns about the board discussing a new name for the school should contact individual board members or email the entire board at schoolboard@usd497.org.

2018-19 Calendar

Jeanne Fridell, Woodlawn Principal and Calendar Committee Co-chair, along with Jill Anderson, Calendar Committee Co-Chair, discussed the changes they incorporated into the 2018-19 district calendar. (Attachments 1& 2)

Some of the key features of the calendar include:

- The first day of school for grades 1-5 on Wednesday, August 15, which is also a half-day orientation for students in grades 6 and 9. The first day for all secondary students will be Thursday, August 16.
- The addition of two Elementary Plan Days on dates that coincide with days the secondary schools are not in session (October 12 and March 1).
- Beginning the staff school year a day earlier than past practice, on Thursday, August 9, to accommodate professional development around the implementation of PowerSchool. To compensate certified staff for the change, elementary staff will have a day off on March 8, when secondary schools are out of school due to conference week. February 22 will be a day off for secondary schools, when elementary schools are closed due to conference week.
- The Back-to-School Kickoff and District Staff Professional Development (PD) Day on Monday, August 13, with all staff, both certified and classified, in attendance.

Reports & Approvals (CONTINUED)

- Winter Break beginning for all students and staff following a full day of elementary classes on Friday, December 21, and a half-day of school for secondary students with Recording/Reporting for secondary staff that afternoon.
- Winter Break continuing through the first week of January.
- An elementary staff Building PD Day and secondary staff PD/Work Day on January 7.
- January 8 becoming the first day back to school for all students in 2019.
- An Inclement Weather Make-up Day on April 19. (No school unless announced.)

Upon a motion by Rick Ingram, seconded by Vanessa Sanburn, the board voted, in a 7-0 roll call vote, to approve the 2018-19 calendar as proposed.

Reports~

Student Confidentiality-Family Education Rights Privacy Act (FERPA) and Staff Confidentiality

David Cunningham, executive director, human resources/chief legal counsel, reviewed the board's responsibility to protect the privacy interests of students and employees.

The rules of student confidentiality are set forth in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 ("FERPA"). Under FERPA, the district designates certain student information as "directory information", which may be disclosed without prior consent.

Mr. Cunningham explained that failure to adhere to the legal requirements can put the district, and depending on the circumstances, individual board members, at risk of liability.

To help provide more clarity surrounding this issue, a Q&A type document will be drafted and posted on the www.usd497 website in the near future.

At 7:49 p.m., a motion was made by Rick Ingram, seconded by Marcel Harmon, to adjourn the regular meeting of the Board of Education. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.
