Welcome to English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) and Title III. ESOL services are made available to students who have a first language that is not English or have a language other than English in this home. Under the No Child Left Behind Act, Title III provides funding to support services designed to enhance English language learners' fluency in English at Limmigrant students' understanding of American culture.

The ESOL/Billingual state funding program is designed to help off-set the cost Kansas school districts incur in their efforts to educate limited English proficient students. ESOL services should provide students with the acade ic and social language they need to succeed in their educational pursuits.

ESOL services may be delivered in conjunction with other State or Februal programs, i.e. Title I, At-Risk, or social services such as the Migrant Health Program or community programs.




### ESL Enrollment





### **ESL** Transportation

- No transportation provided for ESL students

#### **Cluster ESL Sites:**

- Transportation provided for those ESL students not residing in the attendance area



2016-2017 ESL Transportation Cost: \$292,480

\*District is reimbursed for some ESL student transportation expenses when the students live greater than 2.5 miles from the school
