Re: Cisco Cloudlock and Umbrella Protection Software

Background:

For many years, firewall software was adequate for protecting users from dangers and compromises from the outside world. Security software and support is critical to ensure network viability, security protection, and operations. Cisco Umbrella provides the first line of defense against internet threats by providing visibility into internet activity and blocks threats before they reach the network. Cisco Cloudlock secures cloud data and apps against breaches and cloud malware.

Rationale

Security software and support is critical to ensure network viability, security protection, and operations. It provides the Information Technology Services team the support tools needed to protect end users from any type of compromise.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends the Board of Education approve purchasing a 3-year subscription of Cisco Umbrella and Cloudlock software and services with Converged One (AOS) A 3 year cumulative cost of \$179,352. Pricing is off of State contract # KS-C062518, and is to be paid annually from the general fund administrative technology budget. (FY19 \$59,784, FY20 \$59,784, FY21 \$59,784)

Motion:

"I move that the Board of Education approve purchasing a 3-year subscription of Cisco Umbrella and Cloudlock software and services with Converged One (AOS). The 3 year contract cost is \$179,352. Pricing is off of State contract # KS-C062518, and is to be paid annually from the general fund administrative technology budget. 2018-2019 annual expenditure is \$59,784."
