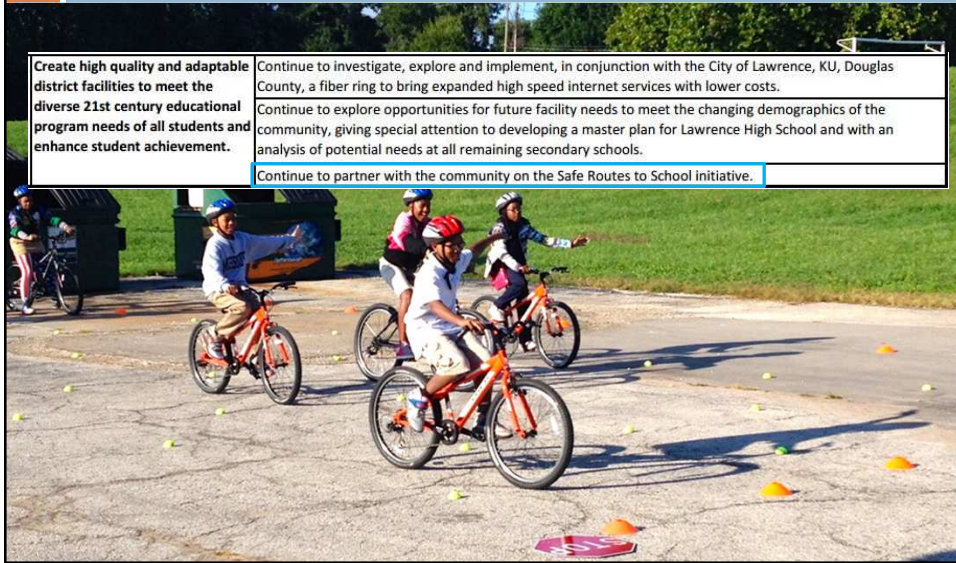
Board Goal

Continue to investigate, explore and implement, in conjunction with the City of Lawrence, KU, Douglas County, a fiber ring to bring expanded high speed internet services with lower costs.

The BLAST program is designed to teach and develop the skills and knowledge required for safe and effective cycling. This curriculum has been developed by bicycle education advocates and reviewed by educators and parents.

The BLAST program is designed to be taught in approximately three hours of class time by trained BLAST instructors with the assistance of the PE teacher. While many of the topics are covered in a classroom setting, the BLAST curriculum includes a riding skills portion where students will practice operating a bicycle in a controlled environment.

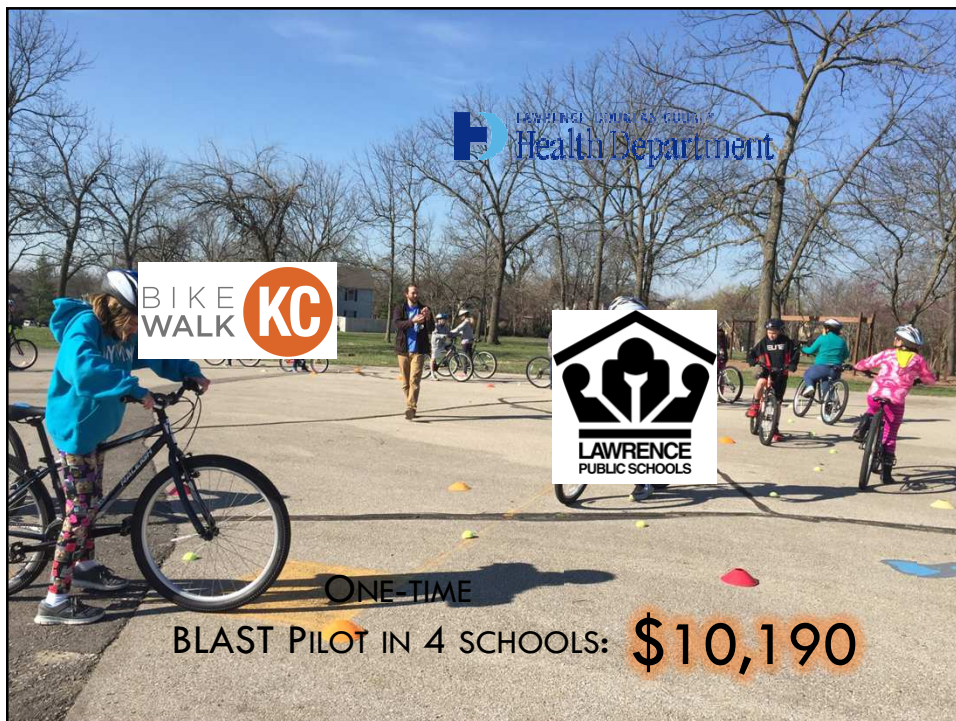
BLAST GOALS
