Re: Sanitary Sewer Improvements – New York

Background:

At its April 28, 2014 meeting, the Board of Education approved the USD 497 2013 Bond Issue Project for bond construction at New York Elementary School. During that project, the need for improvements to the sanitary sewer was identified. The project requires the installation of an 8" sanitary sewer main in the intersection of East 10th and New York Streets.

Bids and Specifications:

The district hired Landplan Engineering, P.A. for the development of project specifications, design and construction administration services.

The request for bids was distributed to multiple local and regional vendors, and the bids are as follow:

RD Johnson Excavating Co., Inc.	\$104,744
Cohorst Enterprises, Inc.	\$149,000
Vito's Plumbing, Inc.	\$168,500
King's Construction Co., Inc.	\$215,000

The low bid from RD Johnson Excavating Co., Inc. was accepted. This price includes a 5% contingency for unforeseen costs.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends board approval of a contract with RD Johnson Excavating Co., Inc. for the installation of a sanitary sewer main at New York Elementary School.
