# Middle School Boundary Criteria

- **LMCMS Students**

- Students may continue enrollment at LMCMS as part of the STEAM program.
- Students may select to attend another Middle School.

- **BMMS, WMS and SWMS Students**

- Students may continue enrollment at their current Middle School.
- Students may select to attend LMCMS as part of the STEAM program.

- **District transfer procedures will be used.**

- **Transportation will not be provided.**





# Parent Concern

- **Email 12/18/23**

- The most immediate problem I feel that can be solved is the bus situation. There is no reason our elementary kids should have a longer day than the administration. Can another route be created? Can the distribution of kids be adjusted for improved time efficiency? In the future, can we look at release times to at least get the kids home before dinner time?
- Students currently attending BMMS - I have heard we are considering moving kids in our area to southwest middle school, I want you to consider the impacts the distances between schools and time strains they have on families. If we are to move to SWMS, please think of the safety of having to use the bypass or the extra time needed to go all the way around through the city.
