"Boundaries should be redrawn to maximize integration by equally dispersing students with different social, economic, racial, and cultural backgrounds at all grade levels, from kindergarten through high school."

Assessment Data Reflection

Worrisome→especially for Native students.

Unified Insights Reflection

What are your recommendations for how this tool can be used to inform instructional practices and to Close the Access, Opportunity, and Achievement Gap?

Focus on the neediest kids.

Social Emotional Learning Pilot Reflection

What does the data show about how we are doing? What recommendations would you like to make in this area?
