Minutes:

- Good news Three student COVID cases in April. We had no staff or student COVID cases reported during the last two weeks of school!
- No issues with mask usage and cleanliness based on feedback from staff committee members. Still tough teaching in person and online.
- Both HS girls soccer teams had to quarantine, and the LHS softball team had to quarantine. Both schools are/will be hosting in person plays with covid mitigations in place.
- Proms will be hosted outside, seniors only, proposals given by HS student council members.
- Graduations will take place outside as previously done, alternate dates just in case of weather. 4 tickets given per graduate, looking to see if it's possible to give additional tickets.
- SB40 (c) (1) An employee, a student or the parent or guardian of a student aggrieved by an action taken, order issued or policy adopted by the board of education of a school district pursuant to subsection (a)(1), or an action of any employee of a school district violating any such action, order or policy, may request a hearing by such board of education to contest such action, order or policy within 30 days after the action was taken, order was issued or policy was adopted by the board of education. Any such request shall not stay or enjoin such action, order or policy.
- Senate Bill 63 states that every school district in this state shall provide a full-time, in person attendance option for every student enrolled in kindergarten or grades 1-12.
- Once you have received your 2nd vaccine and it has been 2 weeks past that date, then you are considered fully immunized.
