- Thoughts regarding winter sports, specifically wrestling, one member thought it was dangerous to wear a mask the entire time.
- Remote option and/or testing for all student athletes. Administrators will discuss the logistics of when to give the tests, committee members had consensus that supports testing and/or remote learning for student athletes.
- Some members recommended not allowing spectators to attend the games and live stream the events. Some believe that the district has done a great job of keeping spectators as far as 10ft apart at sporting events. If there is an ability to keep everyone apart and no concessions so people do not have to take their masks off.
- Philosophical goal of ultimately getting the kids back in school 100%, we should not do things that detract from that.
- We should minimize how much we are taking from kids, they are sacrificing a lot already.
 It should be safer to go to an event than going to the grocery store, and it should not jeopardize kids getting back in the classroom.
- Will there be a full time in person model plan coming, how will the zoom hours fall into that. With the gating criteria, only 15 kids will be allowed in a room, and would need to figure out logistics. When things flip, will we be ready to get right in.
- Compliance Tool Walkthrough tool to determine how well a building is doing at the time adhering to mitigation requirements.
