WRAP services are free and available to all students. The WRAP program is staffed by master's level clinicians employed by the Bert Nash Community Mental Health Center.



The WRAP program is voluntary. There are other ways you can get help for your child and your family if you do not want WRAP services. School principals, counselors, social workers, or WRAP specialists can help you find the best fit.



WRAP provides services based on individual and school needs which may include:

- Individual and small-group skill-building and therapeutic interventions
- Crisis intervention
- Student advocacy and mediation
- Communication between school, home and community
- Family support
- Linking families and children to resources for social and emotional development, academic support and afterschool programs/activities
- Preparation for transitioning to the next grade level or to a new school
- Connecting kids with summer programs
