

College Credit for Your Student

Help your high school student get a head start on their college education and save money on their degree with concurrent credit courses taught by highly qualified instructors either online or in their school.

Students in the concurrent credit program will experience college-level work with layers of support and gain firsthand knowledge about the exciting opportunities Baker U has to offer.

Nursing partnership: Students who plan to pursue a degree in nursing may take their nursing prerequisite courses through the concurrent credit program. This may give them the opportunity for preferred admissions into the School of Nursing.

Scholarship Program

By participating, students may also be eligible for a \$64,000 (over four years) scholarship when they attend Baker full time after high school.

Affordable

\$118 per credit hour, students do not need to buy books, and there are no additional fees.

Online Courses

Self-paced, online delivery is flexible. Active instructors and coaches help students succeed.

In-School Courses

Students take courses on the high school campus during regular school hours from highly credentialed high school teachers, who will help them succeed.

How to Enroll

- Log on to bakerU.edu/ccpRegistration.
- Fill out the secure form and submit credit card payment all at once.
- You must report a 3.00 or higher GPA (ask your counselor about the appeals process if GPA is lower than 3.0).
- Once you report your GPA, select your school, and then course options will appear.
- Select the course for which you are enrolling and would like to earn Baker college credits.
- Complete the remainder of the form and enter payment.
- Click "submit" only one time. The form will be submitted and you will be returned to the opening screen.

SPRING ENROLLMENT PERIOD: JAN. 3 - FEB. 7, 2025

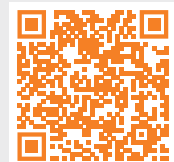
