

Peaslee Technical Training Center

Douglas County High School Youth Apprenticeship Program 2024-2025

Complete post-secondary education while you are in high school!

Peaslee Tech received a grant from the State of Kansas that will help pay up to \$2000 towards an apprenticeship program per each apprentice. This leaves a remaining balance for some of the programs, which the student will be responsible for. (If financial assistance is needed, please reach out to Charlie Lauts, charlie.lauts@peasleetech.org, or Andrea Chavez andrea.chavez@peasleetech.org, as soon as possible.)

Peaslee Tech is pleased to offer 12 different 1-Year Competency Based Registered Apprenticeships. Apprenticeships are paid positions once the student is working with an employer.

On Campus Courses at Peaslee Tech:

Residential Plumber: Class meets Tuesday nights from 5:00 - 8:45 pm starting September 3, 2024 and completing on July 8, 2025. Grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$625 of tuition.

Residential HVAC: Class meets Thursday nights from 5:00 - 8:45 pm starting September 5, 2024 and completing on June 26, 2025. Grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$625 of tuition. Students will earn their EPA 608 certification during the class.



Residential Carpentry: Class meets Tuesday and Thursday night from 5:00 - 8:45 pm starting August 20, 2024 and ending December 19, 2024. Grant covers tuition 100%. Students will frame a house for Tenants to Homeowners during the class.

<u>Facilities Maintenance:</u> Class meets Monday and Wednesday evenings from 5:00 - 8:45 pm starting August 26, 2024. After completion of on campus training the student will begin a paid apprenticeship. Grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$625 of tuition.

<u>CDL-A (Commercial Drivers License):</u> student must be 18 years old to enroll. Grant will cover \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$2620 of the tuition. Once students receive their permit they will be given up to 86 hours of combination vehicle driving instruction in preparation of the driving exam at a state CDL testing site.

Online Course options to complete before starting an apprenticeship.

- 1. Sterile Processing Technician: Grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$795 of the tuition.
- 2. Dental Assistant: Grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$995 of the tuition.
- 3. Veterinarian Assistant: Grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$495 of the tuition.
- 4. Pharmacy Technician: The grant covers 100% of the tuition cost.
- 5. Appliance Repair Technician: The grant covers 100% of the tuition cost.
- **6. RV Technician (must be 18 years old):** The grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$625 of the tuition.

Engineering Assistant: The grant covers \$2000 and the student is responsible for \$625 of the tuition.

Last semester, students chose their classes for the 2024-25 school year. They will be released on PowerSchool on this Thursday, August 1st. While there may be some wishes for changes, most of our classes are full and the schedule does not allow for much flexibility. Once released in PowerSchool this week, please look over your schedule and ensure the following:

1. Seven classes in seven different periods.

2. Have required classes:

a.9th: English 9, Biology, Math

b. 10th: English 10, Science, Math, & World History

c.11th: English, Science, Math, & U.S. History

d.12th: English & U.S. Government



If your schedule is incomplete in any way, please visit with your counselor IN PERSON. We will be hosting an open house for incomplete schedules on the following days and times:

Asthma Inhalers: High School students can and should keep their asthma inhalers with them at all times. Please contact the nurse if you would like the inhalers kept only in the health office.

Epi Pens: Please make sure the nurse knows that your student is keeping an EPI Pen with them in their backpack. If they have a need for emergency EPI PENS, they should have one with them at all times. Please notify the nurse about any changes or a new diagnosis so other staff are aware and can help in an emergency situation.

Seizures: Please notify the nurse if your student has been diagnosed with a seizure condition and has emergency medication to keep at school.

Diabetes: Please notify the nurse of updated diabetes medications and changes. Back-up snacks and medication can be kept in the health office.

OTC/Over-the-counter headache and pain medication (such as acetaminophen and/or ibuprofen, Midol, antacids, etc) can be kept with students. Ibuprofen, acetaminophen, and antacids are both available for no charge in the health office if ever needed.

RX/Prescription medications that are controlled substances (such as those for ADHD, anxiety, and depression), must be administered by the nurse or health office assistant during the school day.

Update on immunizations

- Covid Protocol: USD497 Protocol
- Meningococcal: 2 doses -All students should have a record of at least one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine usually given at 11-12 years of age and a second dose at 11th grade.
- Tdap: Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis: One dose -usually is given in middle school but if your student missed this dose, please make sure they have this before school starts.
- Hepatitis A: 2 doses are required.

Recommended: yearly Influenza vaccine; HPV (Human Papillomavirus) 2 doses if given before age 15; otherwise 3 doses.

Please let the nurse know of any updated health situations that your student may have. We want to keep them healthy and successful for the remainder of the school year! –LHS Health office: 785-330-0721
