

Financial Aid Checklist



2024-2025 Academic Year

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) will open sometime in **December 2023** at www.studentaid.gov.

 Students must apply for admission to Highland Community College and submit all transcripts: Official high school/Home school/GED transcript All official prior college transcripts
 Using your legal name, apply for your Studentaid.gov Account (FSA ID) at www.studentaid.gov. The Applicant (student) and a Contributor (parent or student spouse) must each create their own Studentaid.gov account. If parents filed the 2022 income tax return as Married Filing Separately, each parent will have to create an FSA ID to give consent to retrieve tax return information. If you are completing the FAFSA for the first time, click on "Create Account." If you've applied for federal financial aid before, click on "Log In." Parents who have previously done a FAFSA will use the same Studentaid.gov account (FSA ID) for all their children. If you've forgotten your user name or password, click on "Forgot My Username" or "Forgot My Password" and follow the prompts.
 Information needed to properly fill out the FAFSA: The 2022 tax return of the student and parent(s) Total <u>current</u> amount of cash, savings, checking accounts and net worth of Investments, Businesses, Farms, Real Estate (excluding home in which the student lives) Amount of Child Support received in the <u>last completed calendar year</u>
 Tips for filling out the FAFSA: The Student must begin the FAFSA then invite their parents or spouse to contribute to the form. Parent or spouse will receive the invitation via the email address provided on the FAFSA. If the student's parents are divorced, the parent who provided the most financial support in the last calendar year must be the parent on the FAFSA. Once the student submits their portion, then the parent may complete and submit their portion. 2022 income tax information will be automatically retrieved through the IRS Direct Data Exchange. Students and Contributors must consent to retrieve and disclose federal tax information from the IRS. If consent is not granted, the student will not be eligible for federal student aid. Add the school: Highland Community College School Code: 001921 If you have technical issues with the FAFSA website, contact them directly at 1-800-433-3243.
Once we receive your FAFSA, we will review it for any potential issues and will mail to you a Missing Information letter which will explain what is needed.
Once all processes are complete, you will receive a mailed Financial Aid Offer. It will list all federal aid you are eligible to receive. Review the offer, fill out the "School Copy," including a <u>hand-written signature</u> , and return it to our office via mail, fax, or email
