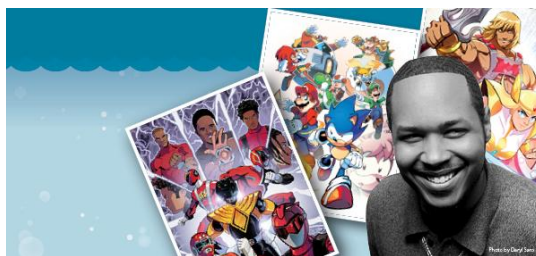

We meet 10 specific standards to get this recognition, one of which is participating in the Kansas Special Olympics Polar Plunge to raise awareness and money for inclusive sporting opportunities.

This year, IPS is bringing an awesome opportunity to LHS clubs, teams, and classrooms in the form of a Cool School Polar Plunge!! As a school, we are again raising money for Kansas Special Olympics, but this year, the plunge is brought to us in a large tank that will be located between the gyms on February 14 at 1:45.

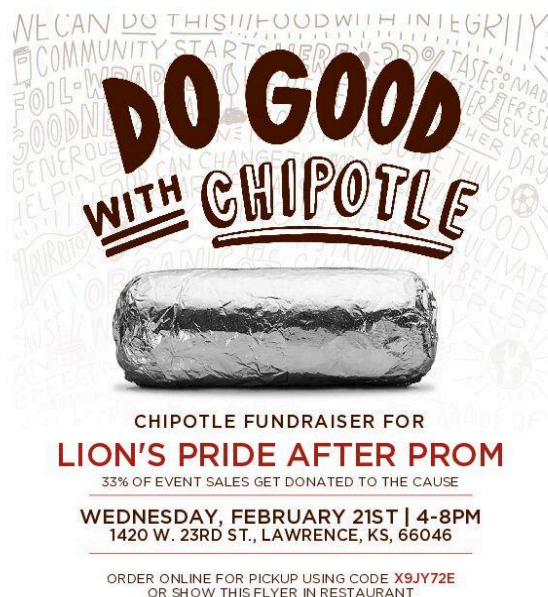

Once at their home page, click "Create Account" in the upper bar of the page.

CREATE AN ACCOUNT

When creating an account, do NOT use your student email (students.usd497.org). Use a personal email. You have completed the 11th Grade. Once you do the initial set up, it will email you a code or link to follow.

3

CHOOSE YOUR SCHOOL

After entering the code or following the link, you will need to choose your school. Make sure you select Lawrence High School in Lawrence, KS.

4

ADD ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Important things to remember:

- You are currently enrolled.
- For the Class of 2024, Earliest Year is 2020 and Expected Grad Year is 2024 (even if you are an early grad in December).
- Waive your FERPA rights.

DASHBOARD

When on this screen, you should see the Chesty Lion on the lefthand side and "Lawrence High School."

ORDER TRANSCRIPT

To order a transcript, click on the plus or the green "Order" button. You can send it to yourself or you can search for an institution. Once you locate your destination, choose select. You have two options: Send Now or Hold. Holding it will send it after graduation with final grades. Also, as long as it is sent electronically, it is free until mid-June 2024. You can check back to see if it has been sent.

What's Coming Up:

While Quarter 3 is considered a slow time but, this is not the case for School Counselors. This is the time of year where we start to get ready for next year with course registration. We also become test proctors with ACT and AP exams. We are out of the office pretty regularly during this time.

Mental Health

Lately, we have discussed mental health as in term of the weather and season. In this letter, we will switch to students handling a classmate's death. It is hard to predict who would be impacted by this. We often assume that impact is related to how much a student knows or interacts with the classmate. This assumption is incorrect. An individual doesn't have to have a strong connection to the student to be impacted. At this age, students still have some belief in immortality or invincibility. The idea that someone a student's age did die is scary. This is compounded by other factors such as nature and abruptness of the death. Check in. 30 seconds, 1 minutes, whatever is needed. We all can be quick to say we're fine but also watch for body language and changes in behaviors.

HEALTH OFFICE

Update on immunizations for 2023-2024 school year

- Covid Protocol: USD497 Protocol
- Meningococcal: 2 doses -All students should have a record of at least one dose of Meningococcal vaccine usually given at 11-12 years of age and a second dose at 11th grade.
- Tdap: Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis: One dose -usually is given in middle school but if your student missed this dose, please make sure they have this before school starts.
- Hepatitis A: 2 doses are required.

Recommended: yearly Influenza vaccine; HPV (Human Papillomavirus) 2 doses if given before age 15; otherwise 3 doses.

PLEASE keep your child home if they are ill!

Asthma Inhalers: High School students can and should keep their asthma inhalers with them at all times. Please contact the nurse if you would like the inhalers kept only in the health office.

Epi Pens: Please make sure the nurse knows that your student is keeping an EPI Pen with them in their backpack. If they have a need for emergency EPI PENS, they should have one with them at all times. Please notify the nurse about any changes or a new diagnosis so other staff are aware and can help in an emergency situation.

Seizures: Please notify the nurse if your student has been diagnosed with a seizure condition and has emergency medication to keep at school.

Diabetes: Please notify the nurse of updated diabetes medications and changes. Back up snacks and medication can be kept in the health office.

OTC/Over the counter headache and pain medication (such as acetaminophen and/or ibuprofen, midol, antacids, etc) can be kept with students. Ibuprofen, acetaminophen and antacids are both available for no charge in the health office if ever needed.

RX/Prescription medications that are controlled substances (such as those for ADHD, anxiety, depression), must be administered by the nurse or health office assistant during the school day. Medication forms are attached.

Please let the nurse know of any updated health situations that your student may have. We want to keep them healthy and successful for the school year!

This form is for parents/guardians who DO NOT WANT their student to participate in the Lawrence Public Schools Hearing & Vision Screening procedures during the 2023- 2024 school year, August 2023 to May 2024.

Lawrence Public Schools conducts Hearing and Vision Screenings mandated by the state of Kansas. To ensure all students can access curriculum and instruction the district screens their Hearing and Distance Vision for concerns that may require further follow-up. The district conducts mass hearing/vision screenings at the schools: ALL Students enrolled in grades PreSchool through grade 12 may be screened. However, we typically attempt to screen all students in grades PreK, Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 10th. {Students in grades not just listed may be screened for select reasons such as, but not limited to: at-risk indicators, missing screening data/absences, new to district, special education needs, other health purposes, etc. Preschool students will receive Hearing screening & Vision screening on different dates due to attention and developmental needs. If you want your child's hearing and vision screening to be completed - DO NOT COMPLETE THIS FORM. We will automatically conduct the screenings in accordance with the district protocol for hearing and vision. If you DO NOT WANT your child to participate in hearing and vision screening during this school year - PLEASE COMPLETE THIS FORM. Use a separate form for EACH of your children/students. This request must be completed by 8:00 a.m. the day before hearing/vision screenings are conducted at your student's school. The date of hearing/vision screenings should be available on your school's calendar and the district website (<https://www.usd497.org/hearingandvisionscreening>) **If completing a paper form - the paper form must be received by 8:00 a.m. the day before screening by the School Nurse or Health Office Attendant. Thank you for your time and attention to this matter.**
