WHAT IS IT?

The Kansas Promise Scholarship Act provides service scholarships for students to attend an "eligible postsecondary educational institution" in specified programs.

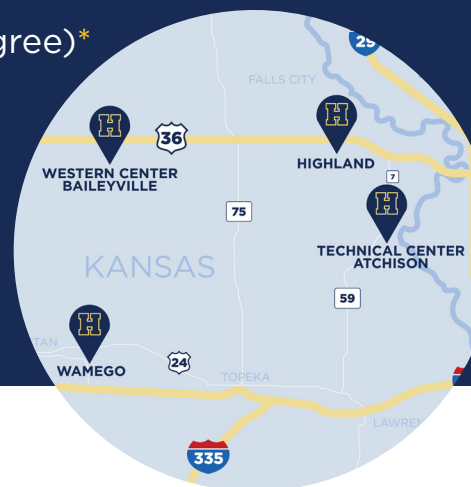

Per HB 2064 section 3b, 4c: an eligible postsecondary educational institution that designates an additional promise eligible program pursuant to subsection (a) shall maintain the promise eligible program designation of such program for at least three consecutive years. After maintaining such program for at least three years, the institution may designate a new promise eligible that corresponds to a high wage, high demand, or critical need occupation to replace existing promise eligible program.
