[Note: Federal law (Section 9528 of ESEA (20 U.S.C. 7908), as amended by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (P. L. 107-110), and 10 U.S.C. 503, as amended by section 544, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2002, (P.L. 107-107), require educational agencies to provide military recruiters, upon request, students' names, addresses and telephone listings, whether or not the information is designated as directory information under FERPA. This law also requires that military recruiters be given the same access to students at school as postsecondary institutions or prospective employers.]
