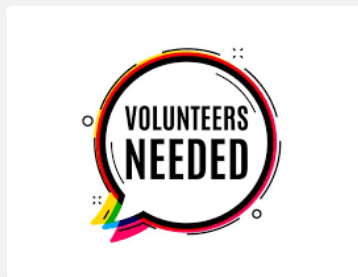

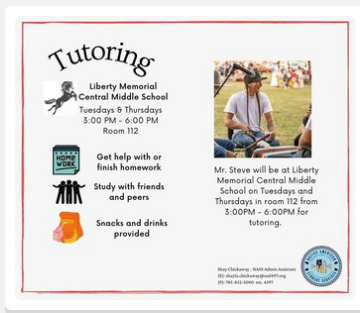

## *Nov. 15 Deadlnt to Claim Child Tax Credits*

Spread the word: families must file before November 15 to claim at least \$3,000/child with the Child Tax Credit this year. Households with low or no incomes across the country could still get thousands of dollars in federal money with the Child Tax Credit - even if they have never filed taxes before (and have not filed taxes this year). But more than 4 million children nationwide could miss out on up to \$3,600 with the Child Tax Credit if their parent/guardian has not yet filed - 21,000 could miss out in Kansas.
