Principal's Report

- State assessments: 3rd and 4th grade have finished; 5th grade still has math to take. Results should arrive May 24th, per Darcie Krauss. These early results will help drive programming for next year. Teachers appreciated getting testing done in a shorter window of time so that instruction could continue with less interruption.
- This is teacher appreciation week. Our PTO has been sharing lots of love with our amazing staff. Students have been showing appreciation and love for staff as well.
- Kindergarten update: We have 21 students fully enrolled for next year; 9 partially enrolled; 5 from Kennedy EC; 2 transfers approved but not yet enrolled; 37 total/25 attended orientation day. Transfers are coming from Kennedy enrollment area.
- 5th grade moving up day is Thursday, May 27 at 9:30 AM. It will be held on the front lawn; four people per family will be allowed to attend. In the event of poor weather, it will be held in the gym.

School Board Report

- Last board meeting went over the ESR application. Kathy Johnson, finance person, attended the meeting to present the financial implications of the application.
- Air quality report was approved.
- The board is making plans for how to pay the significant gas bill that was received for use this winter. Funds may need to be moved around.
- Kelly Walker, the new Native American Student Services person, was introduced at the last board meeting. This department provides resource for Native American youth, such as tutoring and other services and programs.
- A report was given regarding redesign. High schools have been experimenting with class times for next year. Jayci shared some exciting and innovative ideas she has for redesign at Woodlawn in the next few years.
