14-21	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Referrals to Community Resources and services</li> <li>Complete applications according to needs and preferences</li> </ul>	<b>Transportation:</b> Para-Transit Services (aka. T-Lift). Complete “Part A” of application. Age 18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Re-Apply for Kancare (Kansas Medicaid) as an adult. During last year of school	<b>Complete Planning:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discuss services funding issues &amp; funding availability with Targeted Case Manager and MCO Care Coordinator.</li> <li>If funding is available, select Adult Service Providers.
